Kilmacud Crokes GAA Club; Grounds Development Work

To facilitate the beginning of Parc de Burca development work (the Club's main pitch), earlier this year we removed trees along the Club's front entrance avenue off Lower Kilmacud Road. The next phase of this project involves the completion of works on the entrance and avenue – *a private road owned by Kilmacud Crokes* - leading up to the Clubhouse and grounds from Lower Kilmacud Road. This work will involve the partial re-routing and re-surfacing of the road and laying down of a footpath prior to the development of the pitch; a requirement of the planning permission granted. We hereby wish to give advance notice to members, clients/customers and community that this work will begin early in the New Year. Weather permitting, the likely start date is **Jan 3rd 2019**. This work will take 10-15 weeks. **During this time the road will, for health and safety reasons, be closed to all traffic and vehicular access to the club will be from the other entrance located near Linden Lea on Glenalbyn Road.**

Disruption to club activities and services will be mitigated as much as possible. While **pedestrian access from Allen Park Drive to the Club will, as far as possible, be maintained, pedestrian access to Lower Kilmacud Road from the Club or Allen Park Drive will be suspended for health and safety reasons throughout the work.**

The project will be managed by a licensed construction contractor. As we get closer to the start of works, more detailed specific communications will be shared. In the interests of health and safety, we ask members, clients/customers and neighbours adhere to all project signage, information and directions provided. We hope these works will not cause too much inconvenience and thank you in advance for your cooperation in what is very exciting and important work for the future of our club and Kilmacud and Stillorgan communities. Once this aspect of the work is complete we hope to move quickly to complete the development of the pitch itself in line with the planning permission already in place.

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
