





Map No.4 covers the Southeast section of the county which extends to the border with Wicklow and includes the City of Dublin, Dublin Bay, Dalkey, Dun Laoghaire, Bray, and of course Kilmacud / Stillorgan





Map of the Environs of Dublin by John Taylor, 1816





Taylor's Map of the Environs of Dublin, extending 10 to 14 Miles from the Castle, by an actual Survey








Maps of the Roads of Ireland, 1777


George Taylor and Andrew Skinner were surveyors who had already surveyed the roads of Scotland.

They raised over £2,000 from Ireland's noblemen and gentlemen to map the roads of Ireland.

They began their survey in February 1777 and completed it by the end of the year.




A Sketch of the Environs of Dublin by Major Alexander Taylor, 1805–1809











Two images showing the map at different levels of transparency



OSi provided scanned images of almost 1370 maps for about 76 Irish towns and cities.


These 5 and 10 foot to one mile town plan maps date from the latter half of the 19th century.






Ennis Sheet 12, 1878, 5 feet to 1 mile




Cork Sheet LXXIV.45, 1869, 5 feet to 1 mile






Wicklow Town Sheet XXV-47, 1895, 5 feet to 1 mile

The civil parish maps of Dublin were surveyed between 1863 – 1867. Eighty-five parishes are listed, covering both the county and city area.







PARISH OF STILLORGAN 1866






OSi Dublin Parish Maps – Taney Parish 1865







<u>Dublin District Map 1931</u> Ordnance Survey, Scale 1:20,000
















<u>Dublin 6inch Sheet 23 1937</u> Ordnance Survey






